The Best Student Oral Presentation Award

During the 2nd ICAPP Conference a Student Oral Presentation Award Committee will decide on the best two oral presentations given by students in order to encourage students to give talk on their research and gain experience in communicating their results to international academic audience. Committee will gather the Chairpersons of the Conference sessions.

The members of the Committee will judge the oral presentation registered for this competition according to the following criteria:

- Scientific novelty, excellence, and impact
- Concise and clear presentation structure (clear, logical, includes introduction, objectives, methods, results accurately presented, conclusions matching the objectives and the presented results)
- A format and visual balance between text, figures and tables (overall readability scientific & aesthetic)
- Discussion (reply of presenter to questions)

The registered students with the age under 35, who are interested to be included in the best student oral presentation competition, are obliged to confirm their participation in the competition at the registration desk upon arrival to the Conference.

The Student Oral Presentation Award Committee members will select two best oral presentations. Certificates will be awarded to the presenters during the Conference closing ceremony. Certificate will contain the award name, name of the presenting author, and title of the presentation. Awarded presenters will be exempt from paying the registration fee at the next ICAPP conference.
